

2022 BC Winter Games

Zone 1 Biathlon Trials

- Eligible Athletes: Athletes born in 2007 or 2008 who reside in Zone 1
- Event: BC Winter Games trials – biathlon
- When: Monday January 3, 2022
- Where: Kimberley Nordic biathlon range
- Race Format: Sprint competition , 30 second start interval
Penalty loop (100m) for each shot missed
2 shooting bouts – Prone and Prone
- Course: 1.5km x 3 = 4.5km
- Categories: Junior Boys and Junior Girls (born in 2007 or 2008)
- Rifles: Club rifles will be available for race participants if you do not have your own. Rifles will be placed on the mat by their coaches and will only shoot in the prone position. Ammo will be provided for those who do have their own.
- Schedule: 11:00 to 12:00 -- Range and course setup
12:00 to 12:15 – Meeting for athletes, coaches and parents
at the biathlon range and bib pickup
12:15 to 1:00 -- Zeroing
1:15 -- Start of 1st athlete
- Fees: \$5.00 payable upon receipt of race bib

Qualifying for the BC Winter Games:

The top 2 male and top 2 female finishers will qualify to attend BC Winter Games. Wild cards will also be identified.

COVID Requirements:

Everyone participating in the trials must be fully vaccinated against COVID -19. All parents, spectators, volunteers and officials will be required to provide proof of vaccination at the event. All current PHO requirements for covid-19 will be followed and may change without notice.

Volunteers/Officials:
